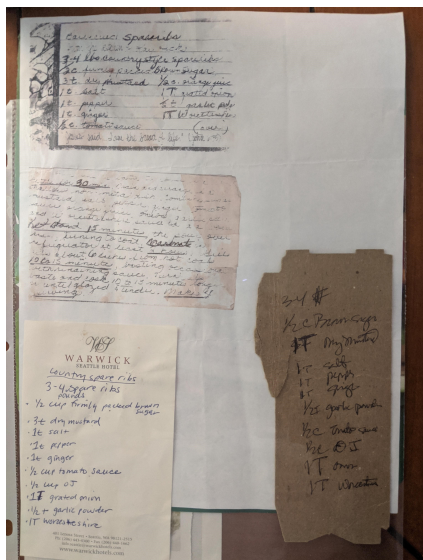




Recipe for: Country Spare Ribs
